Alan G. McNally is chairman of the board and chief executive officer of Harris Bank and Harris Bankcorp, Inc., and vice chairman, Bank of Montreal. He joined Harris as chief executive officer and vice chairman in September 1993, and was elected chairman in April 1995.
